1. Enrollment in an undergraduate Engineering or Engineering Technology curriculum accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) or other accrediting agency recognized by ASHRAE. Students pursuing an associate degree in Engineering Technology need not be enrolled in an ABET-accredited program, but must be pursuing a course of study, which traditionally has been a preparatory curriculum for a career in HVAC&R.
2. Cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0, where 4.0 is the highest
3. Potential service to the HVAC&R profession
4. Need for financial assistance
5. Leadership ability
6. Character

**IMPORTANT:** *An official transcript of all college grades, a letter of recommendation from a professor or faculty advisor, and two additional letters of recommendation* must be submitted in one package and postmarked on or before the application deadline before your application can be considered. Submit only one application. You will be considered for all scholarships for which you qualify. Transcripts and reference letters may be submitted in individually sealed envelopes with the application. Re-applications accepted from former scholarship recipients and applicants.
